





ABOUT THE FOUNDATION

Since 2011, the Foundation for Fairfax County Public Schools has matched community resources to direct needs in the schools. In 2018-2019, the organization built upon its success, raising over \$1,100,000 for individual programs, schools, and initiatives.

A main focus area for the Foundation is the workforce of the future. The Innovation Grant program funds activities that help students imagine possibilities and make connections between classroom learning and future careers, starting in the earliest grades.

In its first year, the Foundation's grant program:

- Helped fourth graders visit GMU's campus for a college tour
- Provided field trip funds so that students in the HVAC program could go behind the scenes at Dulles International Airport
- Allowed students with disabilities to establish student enterprises, like coffee stations, to help them learn real-world skills
- Established an after-school STEM club for Hispanic girls that was in such demand that it was expanded to include over 120 students
- Enabled elementary students to build a vertical farm, using engineering concepts, to showcase creative urban methods of food production
