Program Accomplishments for 2016-2017

Cyber Patriot

- Invested \$50,000 to launch CyberPatriot clubs in 10 middle schools through a partnership with the Community Foundation for Northern Virginia (CFNV)
- Awarded the Chairman's Award from CFNV for our work in cyber
